 - So overall, need to train about 90 people on TTs
 - This is about 12 trips

Part 0: Check ins

Part 1: Check in on action items

- How are we doing on social chairs?
 - Ariel has reached out to a few people (good interest??)
 - Will also re-send email to LC calling for new chairs
- Jedi/Padawan and google form?
 - Google form **for the LC** → ask the same questions asked in part 5 of the trainee scheduling form
 - Trainees have already been asked these questions

Part 2:

- Consolidating gaggle materials for gaggle leaders
 - Will make a shared folder and put gaggle materials in it
 - On top of sending out a curriculum email every week
- Discussing policy for seniors leading TT's and/or trips
 - SC takes
 - Maggie- graduating seniors can lead in-person trips but not virtual trips
 - Brianna - a strong part of FOP leaders is seeing them around campus, and FOPpers would lose that experience
 - Carlos- seniors do want to lead trips still!
 - More tri's in order to accommodate numbers
 - Really interesting perspective to have post-grads as leaders as well
 - Numbers aside, **seniors can still lead trips** (consensus <3)
- Quigs SC Feedback
 - Quigs' vision: every member of SC talks with each other member of SC on a ft call for feedback + checking-in
 - Meeting one other SC member each week, round robin
 - Facilitator from each week is the odd person out, acting as quigs that week
 - Will do this during meetings
 - **Start this week, Carlos will make the pairings**
- Q: How exactly do buddy gaggles work?
 - A: they were modeled after buddy trips this fall, serve the same function of sharing feedback and ideas
 - **Make this more structured**
